Coming into POL 332, I thought that we would be required to watch newscasts in order to discuss how politics were portrayed in the media. Instead, we were required to read multiple documents each week discussing the theories of mass communication. While I believe some of these documents provided important insight, a majority of them were repetitive and unnecessary. Once we handed in summaries of the documents, we would barely ever discuss them in class so if someone did not understand one, their concerns were not voiced. These summaries (ten in all) ended up being worth 50% of our final grade- yet they were not necessary in the least as they were never thought about again. Class days were discussed critiquing the press's coverage of President Obama, which made sense, but all too often there were extensive conversations between the class about useless media stories, such as the "Octamom." We watched an array of movies within class, which were appreciated but often unnecessary. Instead of focusing on real news media, Uscinski chose to focus on other forms of media, such as cartoons and movies from the 1970s. Participation was worth 10% of our grade, but by the last two weeks of classes, there were still many people whose names Uscinski did not seem to know. While I applaud his rule to turn in the rough draft of our final (and only paper) long before the stresses of finals week set in, there is no reason why it should have been worth the same amount as the final draft of the paper.

- The course is very challenging and interesting. I became a better writer and student by being in this course. It also prepared me for my study abroad course this summer.
- I liked all the opportunities we had for extra credit because it helped make up some of the lost points on the early summary grades.
- I enjoyed the variety in the course lectures, and also the grading opportunities.

Course content is decent though the amount of reading can become tedious. In terms of writing quality this course

- has improved (the writing in these comments doesn't count) my writing more than the sum of my ENG 105, 106 and 211 courses.

The course content remains interesting enough that one hardly notices the implicit lessons they pick up along the way.

The array of articles assigned to us presented a perfect blend of what academic writing has to offer. With every type of writing -- from mathematical to empirical study, long and short, objective and biased -- I became acutely aware of what style I prefer and would like to emulate in my future writings. Whether my classmates approved of the articles or not, I believe that a line-up including popular and unpopular articles teaches a far better lesson about writing than merely assigning easy to read assignment. Furthermore I applaud the use of academic articles instead of textbooks. I learned more from this course without spending a dime on texts than some other courses which demanded I buy \$100+ books that barely required use.

Overall I cannot applaud this course enough: wonderful material, excellent teacher, applicable skills. If more classes ran like this, we'd all be better off.

I took this course with some doubts about its legitimacy. I left completely happy with my experience. The readings outside the classroom really subsidized the discussions inside, making it easy to find things to discuss through-out the 3 hour class-time. I was forced to think critically about a subject I had never really thought about in this way before, and the things I learned in this classroom have already opened my viewpoint. Each day while watching or reading any form of media or having a discussion, I am reminded of something that I learned in this class.

As I said, I like the way the class was run. The readings were interesting for the most part and the activities in the class were never useless or boring. I would have enjoyed a slightly stronger emphasis on textual analysis of the actual Constitution, with a little less time on history of ratification, etc. Controversy over Constitutional interpretation provides an interesting topic for exploration - we could have covered that more.

Overall, I enjoyed that the course didn't rely on traditional homework-quiz-test formats. The unique layout inspired me to think more.

Dr. Uscinski not only reminded me why I am a political science major, he also gave me faith in the fact that I was taking away something great with degree I have now earned at the University of Miami. Dr. Uscinski was more than considerate of my career outside of the classroom and made accommodations for me with make up work that were critical to the progress of my job. Without his support and patience with me, I would have been unable to achieve many of the things I did this semester. His lectures were more than informative, they made me think. Professors Mann, Klofstad, and Uscinski are all very good professors. They arranged for a variety of interesting guest lecturers, and their expertise as political scientists supplemented these guest lectures well. I definitely learned a lot in this class. I had expected the course to be more of a weekly discussion about the current events of the election, but instead it was more about the United States election process, some of which I had already learned in previous political science classes.

That being said, I definitely learned a lot of new things in this class, even though it was not exactly what I expected it would be. I definitely recommend that a class for the 2016 election be created, taught by the same professors.

The Sides book was a good choice for the course. I did not like the Civic talk book at all. It was heavily research based and I thought its relevance to the course was minimal. In the future I would recommend breaking this course into two classes a week, as it was very difficult to switch from lecture to guest speaker in one class. It would be more effective if a lecture was held one night a week, and then in the second class the guest speaker would talk. It would also be helpful if the power points were posted on blackboard, as sometimes I was so busy trying to copy what was on the screen that I was unable to properly take notes on what was being said. All in all it was an enjoyable class, and helped with my understanding of our electoral process.

I think a little more of the typical lecture-style presentations from the professors would've enhanced the more subjective viewpoints from guest speakers. I think Professor Mann was especially good at giving organized lectures.

This is not a comment to the specific professor but about this course and similarly formatted courses as a whole: While the guest speakers are what make the course unique, I have found that, for the most part, I learn more from the lectures than I do from the guest speakers. Perhaps a reduction in the number of guest speakers per semester would allow for more lecture time with better discussions that promote critical thinking skills. Because there is only a midterm and final, this encourages students to put off reading and learning the actual material, leaving the guest speakers' talks to be the only source of information for the students, which is not enough. Written responses on Facebook would be better focused if we were to answer a different question each week rather than left to ramble

open-ended-ly for 300 words. I have appreciated the experience overall, but this being my third consecutive large class of this format, I've noticed a pattern. I gain a lot of information I wouldn't have known had I not taken the class but I never feel I've gained a strong command of the subject. Perhaps if another class like this is offered in the future, these adaptations can be made.

I have thoroughly enjoyed this course. I have learned many things about immigration reform that I did not know prior to taking this course. However, I feel as if the class had a "liberal" atmosphere, and I also believe that many students weren't able to think outside the scope of Miami. To my recollection, we only had two Republican speakers and many, many democrats come to speak to our class. The one Republican who evoked a reaction from our class was Tom Tancredo, who in my opinion is a raging wacko who did not represent the Republican party in a decent manner. Through the duration of the class I often found myself wondering how things would be if the American economy collapsed, and people began to illegally migrate to Mexico for a better life. Number one, I find it hard to believe that Mexico would welcome us with open arms and give us benefits that Mexican citizens receive. Number two, this probably wouldn't even be an issue, because I think Mexico would take a more violent approach to dealing with illegal immigration, meaning that they would probably shoot us as soon as we crossed the border. I know I may seem like a "radical", as I am not a liberal as most college aged students are. I feel as if the course could be improved by incorporating more conservative speakers, and creating a learning environment outside the scope of this crazy, beautiful place we call Miami.
